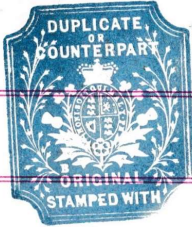

# This Indenture

made the Sixteenth day of October One thousand nine hundred and twenty B E T W E E N

GEORGE WILLIAM SUTER of Nos. 101 103 and 104 High Street Slough in the County of Buckingham Draper of the one part and WILLIAM CLARENCE SUTER of Nos. 101 103 and 104 High Street Slough aforesaid Draper of the other part W I T N E S S E T H that the said George William Suter and William Clarence Suter hereby mutually covenant to become partners in the business of General and Fancy Drapers and Milliners

1. T H E partnership shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty second day of September One thousand nine hundred and twenty and shall continue until determined by six calendar months notice to be given by one partner to the other or to be left at the place of business
2. T H E name of the firm shall be Suter & Son and the business shall be carried on at the premises Nos. 101 103 and 104 High Street Slough aforesaid or at such other place as the partners shall from time to time

3. T H E Bankers of the firm shall be the London County Westminster & Parrs Bank Ltd. Slough Branch \_\_\_\_\_
4. T H E capital of the firm shall be FOUR THOUSAND POUNDS The said capital is at present represented by the Leases and Goodwill of the said premises Nos. 101 103 and 104 High Street Slough aforesaid which has been recently purchased and the Stock in trade trade utensils and other effects upon the said business premises which have also been recently purchased and the cash (balance of the said Capital of Four thousand pounds) standing to the credit of the firm at the said Bank and the said capital shall belong to the Partners in equal shares Either partner who shall with the consent of the other partner bring in additional capital or leave in the partnership business as capital any part of the net profits carried to his credit at any general account the same shall be considered as a debt due to him from the Partnership and shall bear interest after the rate of seven and a half per cent per annum payable half yearly but such additional capital shall not be drawn out by him without giving three calendar months written notice of his intention
