# *Boy hurled into window 'getting better'*



**SIXTEEN - YEAR - OLD**  
Henry Tewkesbury, of  
Cooks-road, Walworth —  
who was flung through  
Suter's window in Uxbridge  
High-street on Friday morn-  
ing in a trolley-bus smash—  
was stated to-day to be  
"getting better."

The boy was trapped by  
the trolley bus, which came  
into collision with a 222 bus  
at the junction of Windsor-  
street and swerved into him.

Firemen worked to free him.  
He was given blood trans-  
fusions at Hillingdon Hospital.  
Later, his left foot was ampu-  
tated.
