



This Indenture witnesseth THAT

George William Suter
of Ledbury
in the County of Hereford

doth put himself apprentice to

George Court of 19 B Summer Lane Birmingham

to learn his Art and after the manner of an Apprentice to serve from the date hereof for the full end and term of two years

During which term the said Apprentice he is M aster, faithfully shall serve, he is secrets keep, he is lawful commands everywhere gladly do and shall do no damage to his said M aster, nor see it done by others, but to the best of his power shall let and forthwith give notice to his said M aster of the same. and shall not waste the goods of his said M aster, nor lend them unlawfully to any. and shall neither buy nor sell without his M asters license and shall not play at cards, dice, tables, nor any unlawful game and shall not haunt taverns nor ale-houses nor absent himself from his said M asters service night or day unlawfully, but in all things as a faithful Apprentice shall behave himself towards his said M aster and all his during the said term.

And the said George Court in consideration of the faithful services of the said George William Suter will instruct the said George William Suter in his Art, Trade, or calling of Drapery which he now useth, after the best manner or way that he can or will cause him to be so instructed: and will also pay to the said George William Suter the sum of ten pounds the second year of the said apprenticeship

And if both parties are agreed, the said George William Suter to remain the third year the said George Court to pay him twenty five pounds per annum, -

AND the said George Court does hereby agrees to find the said Apprentice sufficient Meat, Drink, ~~Clothes, washing,~~ and Lodging, ~~and all other necessaries~~ during the said term. of two years
AND for the true performance of all and every the covenants and agreements herein contained, each of the said parties bindeth himself to the other and others of them by these presents.
