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YET another High-street link with the past is going with the sale of Hopkins and Sons, the men's outfitters, to Suters, Ltd. The shop was established as long ago as 1897 by Mr. H. Hopkins, and of late years the business has been carried on by Mr. W. G. Hopkins and his two brothers.

I understand that the family is retiring from business and this is the reason for their decision. A pleasing thing is that all the employees are to be retained by the new owners.

Incidentally, this will be the first venture of Suters in men's outfitting in Slough. Before the firm has confined itself to women's wear.

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
